Discounts

- Early Registration Bonus if registered before April 15: Receive a \$100 discount toward your 2021 Family Camp registration.
- Pastoral Discount if registered before April
 15: 10% off a pastor's camp cost, per family
 attending from the member's church, will be
 applied at registration once the pastor provides
 a list of his church families. (Example: If two
 families from the same church attend camp, the
 senior pastor would receive a 20% discount, or
 the discount would be divided among another
 key promoter.)
- Maximum Family Charge if registered before April 15: \$1,100 for family of six or fewer/\$1,400 for family of seven or more. Please note: discount applied to family units (parents and their children). The maximum family charge does not include accommodation upgrade.

Cancellation Policy

The \$200 registration fee is required before a registration can be processed and will be applied to the total camp fee. Registration fees may be refunded if registrations are canceled more than 30 days prior to the event. Within 30 days of the event, registration fees are nonrefundable but may be transferred to another camper or to Northland Camp for the current season only. All remaining balances will be fully refunded.

Additional Financial Info

- Registration is confirmed with completed form and \$200 registration fee.
- Accommodation requests are given on a firstcome, first-serve basis. Housing may not be guaranteed.
- A statement for the balance is issued upon receipt of payments.

Check-in & Registration

Monday from 2-4 p.m.

Easy Check-in

Upon arrival, you will be given a family vacation packet with your room assignment. You may register during the scheduled registration time, or if you prefer, you may take care of your registration details within 24 hours of arrival after your family gets settled.

Check-in

- Rooms are available for check-in after 2 p.m. on Monday.
- Additional Early Arrival Cost (Saturday or Sunday Check-in):
 - If registered by April 15, 2019: \$25 per family, per night
 - If registered after April 15, 2019: \$75 per family, per night
 - · Check-in on Saturday: 7-10 p.m.
 - · Check-in on Sunday: 2-4 p.m.
 - Meal tickets can be purchased individually for Saturday and Sunday upon arrival.
 - · Some programs are open and free.

Housing Options

Pioneer Lodges

Our beautiful family resort is located across the lake from the main campsite. Rooms are air-conditioned/heated with a loft, oversized bathroom, and bunkbeds for 12 people. This is a nice option for families who bring along bicycles or who enjoy a little extra walking. There is an additional \$200 charge for these rooms because of their size and air-conditioning/heat. Our eight lodge cabins are recommended for larger families.

Lakeside & Timberside Cabins

These center court rooms are located close to the Dining Hall, Chapel, Daily Grind coffee shop, and Rec Hall. Each room houses 6-8 people, and some include full or queen beds. These rooms are convenient for large families with small children. We

are happy to offer air conditioning in all of the center court cabins for an additional charge—\$75 per room/week for rooms with just bunk beds (sleeps 6-8) or \$100 per room/week for rooms with a queen/ full bed and bunk beds (sleeps 6).

Heritage Inn

This option has three floors with 60 available rooms and is located a short walk from the main activity area. Each room houses up to six people. Facilities include a private bathroom, public kitchen, and handicapped-accessible rooms (if requested).

RV/Tent Sites

Contact the office for availability and reservations. Camp prices remain the same for this option.

Activities

Activities include: two indoor gymnasiums, individual and family competitions and tournaments, escape rooms, hammock village, craft shop, snack shop, zipline, waterfront, coffee shop, climbing wall, mini-golf, basketball, volleyball, ping pong, Frisbee golf, laser tag, family challenge course, and much more!









Youth Program

With these age-specific youth programs, we hope to make your camp experience great for the whole family!

Nursery

Nursery is available for ages 0 to 2 years old, and is led by well-trained staff who have experience working with young children. The program is well managed with scheduled playtime, snack time, and age appropriate games and activities. Nursery meets during all morning sessions and evening services, and additional help with children is available throughout the week. For details, please see our Family Camp Coordinator.

Toddlers

Toddler group is available for children 3 to 5 years old. Leaders have prepared age-appropriate Bible lessons, crafts, and activities, as well as scheduled games and snack time. This group meets during all morning sessions and evening services. Additional childcare is available throughout the week. Please see our Family Camp Coordinator for details.

First-Third & Fourth-Sixth

These groups will meet together for most Bible lessons, crafts, games and snack times. Some activities may be divided by age depending on the size of the class. This group meets during all morning sessions and evening services.

Teens

Teen group allows teens to connect with each other as well as the group leaders. The group will meet in the morning for challenges from God's word, singing, and games. Special teen-only activities may be held in the afternoons or evenings and will be announced throughout the week. Since this class only meets in the morning, it gives teens the opportunity to attend evening services with the adults.

Frequently Asked Questions

Can families not familiar with Northland attend?

Absolutely! Families seeking a familyfriendly, Christian atmosphere are welcome to register. We have new families attend each year that then become regular camp attendees.

How structured is the family camp schedule?

Because of the number of people participating in camp programs and events, we provide a detailed schedule so that we can be as organized as possible to serve our family campers. At the same time, our family campers are encouraged to participate in the weekly schedule to the extent they choose. Generally, each family uses the schedule as a guide rather than an obligation.

Who can attend family camp?

Anyone! Of course, Mom and Dad bring the kids, but sometimes, it is just a single parent with the children, or grandparents who bring grandkids with them. Even widows and couples who no longer have any children with them have enjoyed the fellowship with other adults and the programs available to them.

Do families really have a good, solid vacation experience?

Once you come, you will experience a vacation like no other. It is relaxing and helpful at the same time.

How many families can attend?

It really depends on how many cabins are available. Generally speaking, as many as 100-125 families can attend family camp.

Absolutely not! In fact, after coming to family camp, our adults cannot wait to return for other programs throughout the year. We write a completely different schedule and program for our adult groups which they thoroughly enjoy.

How does the cost of family camp differ from other vacation costs?
